What is the PMP?

Managed by the Texas State Board of Pharmacy, the Texas Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) is an online tool that tracks all prescription data for Schedule II-V controlled substances dispensed by pharmacies to Texas residents. The PMP gives registered users immediate access to real-time patient prescription data so prescribers and pharmacies can make informed decisions when prescribing and dispensing controlled substances.

Help reduce controlled substance abuse by making the PMP a part of your prescribing practices.

Alarming Reality

Since 1999, deaths from prescription opioids have more than quadrupled.¹ Every day, 91 Americans die from an opioid overdose.¹
