These members often require coordinated care, daily living support, and community-based services.

Your Role as an LTSS / ALF Provider

Contracted providers support members through:

- Personal care and supervision.
- Assistance with Activities of Daily Living (ADL).
- Meal services and nutrition support.
- Medication assistance (as permitted by license).
- Collaboration on individualized service plans.

Providers operate within state licensing rules while partnering with Superior for care coordination.

Care Coordination Support

- Collaboration with a Superior care manager.
- Communication related to service plans and care transitions.
- Ongoing coordination to support member safety and quality of life.
