## **Description**

Arimoclomol (Brand Name®/TM) is a molecular chaperone activator of the heat-shock proteins.

## FDA Approved Indication(s) [Pending]

Arimoclomol is indicated for the treatment of Niemann-Pick disease type C (NPC).

## Policy/Criteria

Provider must submit documentation (such as office chart notes, lab results or other clinical information) supporting that member has met all approval criteria.

It is the policy of health plans affiliated with Centene Corporation® that arimoclomol is medically necessary when the following criteria are met:

## I. Initial Approval Criteria\*

\*Criteria will mirror the clinical information from the prescribing information once FDA-approved

## A. Niemann-Pick Disease Type C (must meet all):

- 1. Diagnosis of NPC confirmed by one of the following (a or b):\*
  - a. Genetic analysis indicating mutation in both alleles of NPC1 or NPC2;
  - b. Genetic analysis indicates mutation in one allele of NPC1 or NPC2, along with one of the following (i or ii):
    - i. Positive filipin staining test result;
    - ii. Oxysterols elevated at > 2 times the upper limit of normal;
- 2. Prescribed by or in consultation with an endocrinologist or metabolic disease specialist;\*
- 3. Age between 2 and 18 years at therapy initiation;\*
- 4. Member presents with at least one neurological symptom of the disease (for example, but not limited to, hearing loss, vertical supranuclear gaze palsy, ataxia, dementia, dystonia, seizures, dysarthria, or dysphagia);\*
- 5. Member is able to walk either independently or with assistance;\*
- 6. Documentation of baseline NPC Clinical Severity Scale (NPCCSS) score;\*
- 7. Dose does not exceed 600 mg per day.\*

**Approval duration: 6 months**

- 1. Member meets one of the following (a or b):
  - a. Currently receiving medication via Centene benefit or member has previously met initial approval criteria;
  - b. Member is currently receiving medication and is enrolled in a state and product with continuity of care regulations (*refer to state specific addendums for CC.PHARM.03A and CC.PHARM.03B*);
- 2. Member is responding positively to therapy;\*
- 3. If request is for a dose increase, new dose does not exceed 600 mg per day.\*
